

Dangerous Goods Licence-

A dangerous goods driver licence is only required for transport of dangerous goods in the following cases:

- (a) in a receptacle with a capacity of more than 500L
- (b) if there is more than 500kg in a single receptacle
- (c) in the case of intermediate bulk containers (IBCs), where the total capacity of all IBCs is more than 3,000L or where any IBC is filled or emptied while on a vehicle.

- RTA Driving History Print Out. Must be within the last 6 months. If you have moved from interstate, you will require a print out from that state for any time in the 5 year period.

- Photocopy of your drivers Licence
